This term, Year 4 will be developing their curiosity, respect and confidence as learners. Below is an overview of the learning taking place across the Spring term.

### English

Texts studied:

- Queen of Darkness: Boudica's Army – Tony Bradman
- Let Me Touch the Sky – Valerie Bloom (Poetry)

Children will retell key events from stories, write third-person narratives, explore historical viewpoints, and perform and write poetry.

Spelling and handwriting will focus on word endings such as -tion, -sion, -ssion, -cian and the suffix -ation, alongside neat joined handwriting.

- Design Technology – designing, making and evaluating purposeful products

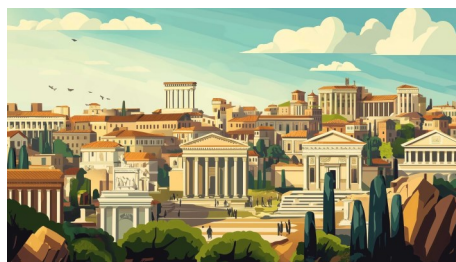
### Computing
