



Welcome to the Summer Term of Year 4.

This term, in **History and Geography** we will: explore the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons, learning who they were, why they came to Britain, and how geography influenced where they settled and how they lived.

In English we will explore Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo, Arthur and the Golden Rope by Joe Todd Stanton, The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane and Bright Bursts of Colour by Matt Goodfellow

The mathematical concepts we will cover throughout summer are time, decimals, money length, mass and volume, area and perimeter, and geometry.

In Art, we will create Viking and Anglo-Saxon inspired digital illustrations using a range of tools, while exploring the work of Sonia Delaunay and applying bold colour, pattern and design techniques to develop their own storytelling.

Our **DT** is linked to our electricity unit. We will design and create a light-up box by exploring simple electrical circuits, including series circuits with switches, and applying the design process of researching, designing, making, testing and evaluating.
