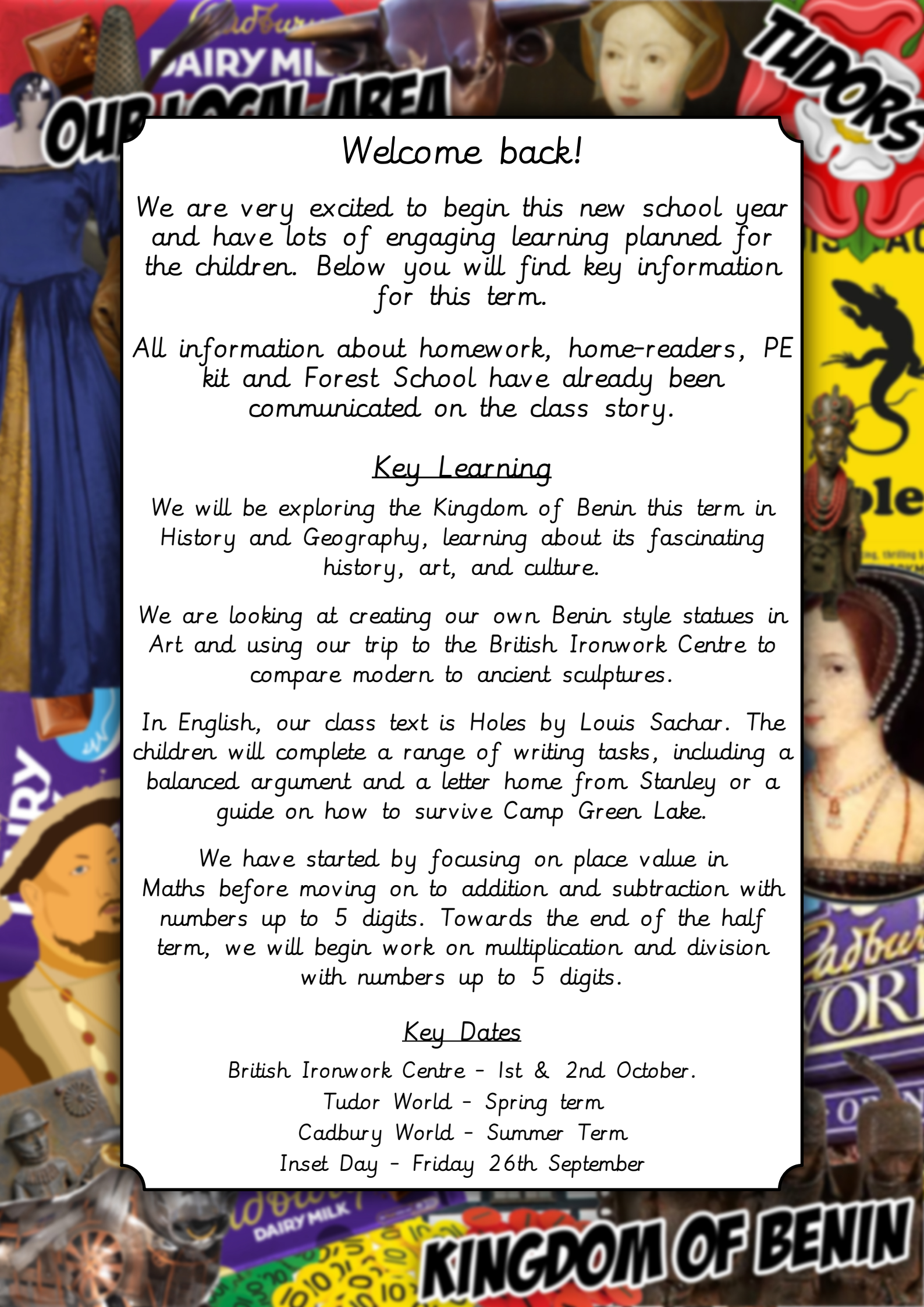




Welcome back!

We are very excited to begin this new school year and have lots of engaging learning planned for the children. Below you will find key information for this term.

Key Learning

We will be exploring the Kingdom of Benin this term in History and Geography, learning about its fascinating history, art, and culture.

We are looking at creating our own Benin style statues in Art and using our trip to the British Ironwork Centre to compare modern to ancient sculptures.

In English, our class text is Holes by Louis Sachar. The children will complete a range of writing tasks, including a balanced argument and a letter home from Stanley or a guide on how to survive Camp Green Lake.

We have started by focusing on place value in Maths before moving on to addition and subtraction with numbers up to 5 digits. Towards the end of the half term, we will begin work on multiplication and division with numbers up to 5 digits.
