SUMMER TERM 2026

English

During our English sessions, we will be looking at a range of both fiction and non-fiction texts. We will be rehearsing all the skills we have learnt this year such as correct punctuation (capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks), using a range of conjunctions, using the 4 different sentence types and spelling common exception words correctly.

Maths

This term we will be covering a range of topics, including the 3d shapes, fractions, time and volume. In addition to this, we will also be recapping the arithmetic skills, covering the addition, subtraction, multiplication and division questions. It would be excellent for children to keep practising their 2,3,5 and 10x tables, in preparation for year 3.

Topic

History - Heroes of History

This term in History, the children will learn about inspiring individuals who made a difference to the world. We will explore the lives and achievements of Neil Armstrong, Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole, discovering why they are remembered as heroes and how their actions helped others.

Geography - Heroic Journeys Around the World

In Geography, pupils will explore exciting journeys made around the world. They will learn about different countries and continents, follow famous routes on maps, and develop their understanding of how people travel and explore our planet.

Science

Living Things and Their Habitats

This term in science, the children will learn about living things and the habitats they live in. They will explore different environments, identify plants and animals that live there, and begin to understand how living things depend on their habitats to survive.

P.E and Forest Schools

Our P.E. day is Wednesday. Please ensure that your child is wearing all the correct PE kit, so they can take part in the weekly pe sessions.

In Summer 1 (the first half term) PE will also be on Tuesdays and in Summer 2 (after half term), this will then change to Forest Schools on a Tuesday where the children will need their wellies.

Homework and Home-Readers

Just a reminder that all children need to have their home reader diaries signed with a comment for their books to be changed. Everyone has been brilliant with bringing their homework in on the correct days, so let's keep it up for the final term! Weekly spellings will continue to be given out on Monday, ready for spelling tests on Fridays.
